

Scandinavian Heritage Days Quilt Show Guidelines May 23 and May 24, 2025

This is an informal non-judged show with the goal of promoting the art of quilting, and encouraging quilt-makers of all levels to share their work.

How to Enter:

A quilt-maker may submit up to two quilts. In the event that more quilts are entered than there is room for, selection of entries will be at the discretion of the show committee.

Quilts may be pieced, appliquéd, machined or hand quilted. You may enter large, small, miniature or other quilted items. Tied quilts are not encouraged.

Bring quilts to the Ephraim CO-OP on Wednesday, May 21 from 4 to 7 pm, or Thursday morning from 10 am to noon. You may also call **Marcia Christensen (435-851-4061)** to arrange a drop off time.

Quilts must be brought in with the submitter's name, address and phone number attached to the back of the quilt.

An entry form must be complete and submitted with each quilt. The bottom portion of the entry form will be displayed on the front of your quilt for the public to read. Please make it as legible as possible.

Submit quilts in disposable plastic bags. Pillowcases/individual carrying cases are discouraged.

Calendar of Events:

Wednesday, May 21: Quilts may be brought to the Ephraim CO-OP building from 4 to 7 pm.

Thursday, May 22: Quilts may be brought to the Ephraim CO-OP building from 10 am. to noon.

Friday, May 23: Quilt Show open for viewing 12:00 to 9:00 p.m.

Saturday, May 24: Quilt show open for viewing 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Pick up quilts at 5:30 p.m.

If you are not available to pick your quilt up on Saturday, you may claim it at the home of Marcia Christensen 435-851-4061

Awards

People's Choice Awards for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will be given.

If the quilt was not made by the submitter, it will be displayed but not voted on.
